Dear Hill School Family –

The leadership team has spent time reviewing the Tarrant County order that directs all public and non-religious private schools to begin remotely until September 28, 2020. While all along our goal has been to begin the 2020-2021 school year on campus, our first priority is to reopen safely, with the safety and well-being of our students, faculty and staff at the forefront. Therefore, after much deliberation and consultation with health and legal experts, Hill School will follow the Tarrant County order for no in-person learning until September 28th.

With this in mind, the opening weeks in August will look a little different than originally planned. To ensure a smooth transition to remote learning, our team has changed the opening weeks of school to include technology training for all parents and students. A new Family Calendar will be emailed next week.

Important dates:

- August 13 – 15 - computer, class materials & remote supply list pick up
 - This includes all lower, middle & upper school students. Pick up days and times will be announced in the coming days.
- August 17 & 18 – parent conferences and parent training technology sessions via Microsoft Teams
 - Your student’s advisory or homeroom teacher will be reaching out to set up a time to meet.
- The week of August 24 – parent and student education and small group trainings via Microsoft Teams
- August 31 – first day of remote learning

Finally, with everyone returning remotely, the typical school day will follow a modified schedule. You can look forward to receiving your student's class schedule along with more specific remote learning details in the coming weeks.
